Welcome to La Isla Bonita Elementary School community! We're excited to have your child join us this year. Below is important information to help ensure a smooth and successful school year for your child.

# 1. Registration Fee & Monthly Payments

- A one-time **non-refundable** registration fee of \$300 is required upon enrollment along with an advanced payment of \$350 for the month of September to ensure reservation of space.
- Monthly tuition is \$350, due on the first Monday of each month. Payments can be made via bank transfer or in office. Please ensure timely payments to avoid a late fee of \$25 per week after the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month. Please note tuition fees will be billed one month in advance.
- NOTE: if your child will not be attending classes for more than a month, you must inform the school principal and will be required to continue paying school fees in order to hold your child's space.

## 2. School Hours

• School hours are from 8:00a.m to 1:00p.m. Students need to be in school before 8:00a.m and picked up no later than 1:30p.m. In the event that you cannot pick up your child on time, please inform the school principal or teacher, as we are **not** responsible for your child outside school hours.

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- The strict latecomers policy enforces that students who arrive after 8:00a.m will not be allowed to attend classes. A 15-minute grace period is provided to accommodate unforeseen emergencies and must inform the school principal.
- Students will have a short 20-minute break for snacks and relaxation. Students can bring food, snacks and drinks from home or purchase from the school snack shop.

#### 3. Dress Code

- Students are required to wear school uniform to school from Monday-Thursday. Children can wear either tennis or black shoes only. Girls need to wear their hair tied up. On Fridays, students can wear own clothes on "casual wear day" and pay \$1.00. All clothing should be neat, clean, in good condition and appropriate for school activities and not distracting or disruptive.
- Students are required to wear PE uniforms, as mandated and enforced by the school.
- Special Dress Days: There will be occasional themed days. Information will be provided ahead of time.

## 4. School Activities & Events

- School meetings will be held throughout the school year with teachers and parents to discuss important topics such as school activities or other issues. It is important that every single parent participates in any school meeting or school function. A fee of \$10 is charged if a parents or someone in your presence does not attend.
- Extracurricular Activities: Our school offers a variety of clubs and sports teams. We encourage students to participate and explore their interests.
- Special Events: Event dates and details will be shared on our school website/ yearly school calendar.
